## Directions to Cold Lake and/or Hamilton House Bed and Breakfast Inn – The "Woodland Oasis"

## From Edmonton Int'l airport - approx 3.5 hours

You will leave the airport heading East, passing through the town of Nisku.

Drive approx 12 miles (19 kms) until you intersect with Hwy 21.

At Hwy 21 turn left or North, travelling on Hwy 21 for approx 50 minutes.

Pass along the East side of the town of Sherwood Park.

Pass through the town of Fort Saskatchewan, staying on Hwy 21. Lots of shopping here.

Hwy 21 will curve to the Northwest and then swing East after Ft. Sask.

At the truck stop corner, 1.5 Km short of Lamont turn left or Northeast, (If you miss this you will drive into and through Lamont and can turn north there).

This short road will travel East for 3 kms and intersect with Hwy 831. Turn left or North onto Hwy 831.

Stay on Hwy #831, travelling North, until you come to Hwy 28 at the town of Waskatenau, turn right or East onto Hwy 28.

Stay on Hwy 28, approx two hours, right through Bonnyville.

At the East end of Bonnyville you may turn left (at the new Recreation centre), which takes you back onto Hwy 28 and straight into Cold Lake, or you may go straight ahead at the recreation centre travelling the "scenic back road" to Hwy 55 approx 20 minutes.

**IF** you turn at the recreation centre and stay on Hwy 28 towards Cold Lake, you will travel approx 20 minutes, until you pass over the Beaver River Bridge.

One mile past the bridge you will see a T intersection, north/South, at Hwy 28 and 55, with a right turn (east) this takes you on to Hwy 55 to Cherry Grove and Hamilton House approx 10.2 kms. Here you may also continue straight into Cold Lake on hwy 28, approx 3 kms.

**IF** you choose the back road (very nice road, great scenery), you will travel approx 20 minutes, until you pass over the Beaver River Bridge, (a different bridge) then meet Hwy 55 at an east/west T intersection.

Turn right and Travel East 9.5 kms on hwy 55 through the Hamlet of Cherry Grove. Our signs are along the right side of the road. At the Eastern edge of Cherry Grove, turn left; we are 200 meters off the highway with signs at the gate.
